## LATAM ENTRY REQUIREMENTS AND VACCINATION STATUS

LATAM entry requirements as of 7 July 2021\*

COUNTRY	ENTRY REQUIREMENTS
Argentina	Most foreigners, who are not a resident in Argentina, will not be permitted to enter Argentina.  Curfew in place from 00:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.
	<ol> <li>NEGATIVE COVID-19 PCR TEST TAKEN WITHIN 72 HOURS BEFORE TRAVEL</li> <li>ALL PASSENGERS ARRIVING IN ARGENTINA WILL BE REQUIRED TO UNDERGO A COVID-19 PCR TEST ADMINISTERED BY LOCAL HEALTH OFFICIALS. In the event that the requested entry is denied, the passenger will be ordered to depart on the next available flight or means of transport</li> <li>10-DAY QUARANTINE from the date of the negative PCR test.</li> <li>Persons returning to the City of Buenos Aires by private vehicle may be required to obtain a Covid-19 test within 24 hours of arrival at city-designated locations.</li> </ol>
Belize	<ul> <li>(1) PROVIDE PROOF OF HAVING RECEIVED TWO FULL DOSES OF COVID-19 VACCINE TWO WEEKS BEFORE ARRIVAL, OR</li> <li>(2) NEGATIVE PCR TEST CARRIED OUT 96 HRS PRIOR TO TRAVEL or RAPID ANTIGEN TEST HRS PRIOR TO TRAVEL</li> <li>(3) Upon arrival, RANDOM SECONDARY TESTING, except: proof of having received two full doses of COVID-19</li> </ul>
Brazil	(1) TRAVELER'S HEALTH DECLARATION (2) NEGATIVE PCR TEST CARRIED OUT 72 HRS PRIOR TO TRAVEL, except: - Children under the age of twelve, who are travelling with a companion - Children under 2 years of age - Flight crews provided they follow special guidelines
Chile	Only Chilean citizens and foreign residents of Chile may enter Chile. The borders will remain closed
	until July 14. There is a daily curfew from 10:00 pm to 5:00 am, nationwide.  (1) COMPLETE "AFFIDAVIT OF TRAVELLERS"  (2) PROOF OF A HEALTH INSURANCE POLICY, with coverage for COVID-19  (3) NEGATIVE PCR TEST FOR COVID-19 CARRIED OUT 72 HRS PRIOR TRAVEL  (4) 10-DAY QUARANTINE (mandatory)
Colombia	The borders with Panama and Ecuador remain closed. Travellers coming from India are prohibited
	from entering.  Various cities in Colombia are instituting curfews, based on ICU capacity.  No tests results are required,
Costa Rica	(1) COMPLETE ONLINE THE HEALTH PASS (2) TRAVEL INSURANCE (mandatory)
Dominican Republic	No tests results are required, however, rapid tests are performed on randomly selected travellers upon arrival. Since 3 March, a nationwide curfew has been in place.
Ecuador	(1) NEGATIVE COVID-19 RT-PCR or RAPID ANTIGEN TEST TAKEN NO MORE THAN THREE DAYS BEFORE TRAVEL, except: (1) airline crew; (2) children age two and under; (3) fully vaccinated travellers, who will present a vaccination card; and (4) travellers previously diagnosed as COVID positive, but with more than one month since the onset of symptoms, may present a medical certificate from their country of origin attesting to their recovery and current good health.

COUNTRY	ENTRY REQUIREMENTS
El Salvador	(1) <b>NEGATIVE PCR TEST CARRIED OUT 72 HRS PRIOR TO TRAVEL,</b> expect passengers showing a proof of completed vaccination
Guatemala	Foreigners who have visited Brazil, the United Kingdom or South Africa within the past 14 days are not permitted to enter.  (1) NEGATIVE COVID-19 PCR OR ANTIGEN TEST RESULT WITHIN 72 HOURS PRIOR TRAVEL, expect: passengers showing a proof of completed vaccination at least two weeks before arrival, or a proof of recovery from COVID-19 within three months of arrival.
Guyana	Guyana has a nationwide curfew from 10:30 p.m. until 4:00 a.m.  (1) NEGATIVE PCR TEST RESULTS MUST BE SUBMITTED ELECTRONICALLY AT LEAST 24  HOURS BEFORE ARRIVAL. If test results are more than 72 hours old upon flight departure for Guyana, the traveler must be re-tested at the airport.
Honduras	Non-resident Honduran citizens and tourists coming from the United Kingdom or South Africa or having visited or transited through those areas in the last 21 days are restricted from entering.  Honduras has a curfew from 10:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.  (1) COMPLETED ONLINE PRECHECK FORM  (2) NEGATIVE PCR TEST
Mexico	Non-essential travel along the U.SMexico land border is restricted at least until 21 July 2021.  Local curfews in place. Restrictions vary based on state and/or city.  A negative COVID-19 test is not required for entry,
Nicaragua	(1) NEGATIVE PCR TEST
Panama	Effective 3 May 3 2021, travellers who have been in or who transited through the United Kingdom, India, South Africa, or any country in South America must provide proof of a negative COVID test within the last 48 hours. These travellers will also undergo molecular testing upon arrival.  Local curfews in place. Restrictions vary based on state and/or city.  (1) NEGATIVE PCR OR ANTIGEN TEST RESULT WITHIN 48 HOURS PRIOR TRAVEL. •If not tested, or the test was done more than 48 hours before travelling to Panama, passengers are required to take a test at the airport.  (5) COMPLETED ELECTRONIC SWORN AFFIDAVIT prior to check-in.
Paraguay	Curfew in place between 20:00 pm and 05:00 am.  (1) NEGATIVE RNA TEST (RT-PCR, NAAT, OR NAAT) TAKEN NO MORE THAN 72 HOURS PRIOR TO ENTERING THE COUNTRY.  (2) 7-DAY QUARANTINE if travellers are coming from Brazil, addition to the pre-entry test  (3) INTERNATIONAL MEDICAL INSURANCE  (4) COMPLETED THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH'S FORM
Peru	Entrance of non-resident passengers travelling from Europe, Brazil, India or South Africa (or travellers who have transited there in the last 14 days) is suspended.  Local curfews in place.  (1) NEGATIVE REAL-TIME COVID-19 MOLECULAR (RT-PCR), NEGATIVE ANTIGEN TEST RESULT, or A MEDICAL CERTIFICATE OF EPIDEMIOLOGICAL DISCHARGE that is no more than 72 HOURS OLD after being issued and before boarding the plane.
Puerto Rico	<ul> <li>(1) COMPLETED TRAVEL DECLARATION</li> <li>(2) PROOF OF BEING FULLY VACCINATED WITH THE MODERNA, PFIZER OR JANSSEN VACCINES, OR MUST PROVIDE EVIDENCE OF A NEGATIVE MOLECULAR OR ANTIGEN TEST FOR COVID-19 PERFORMED WITHIN THE72-HOUR PERIOD PRIOR TO YOUR ARRIVAL. Any passenger arriving without a PCR test result will get a USD 300 fine.</li> </ul>
Uruguay	Uruguay's airports and borders are closed to nonresident foreigners.  (1) NEGATIVE PCR TEST RESULTS, CARRIED OUT UP TO 72 HOURS BEFORE THE START OF THE TRIP  (2) AFFIDAVIT STATING THE ABSENCE OF SYMPTOMS  (3) MEDICAL INSURANCE WITH SPECIFIC COVERAGE FOR COVID-19
Venezuela	(1) NEGATIVE COVID-19 PCR TEST PERFORMED WITHIN 48 HOURS OF BOARDING THEIR INCOMING FLIGHT. All individuals will be subjected to a further COVID-19 PCR test at port of entry
